2. The status of my scholarship application is dependent on the availability of slots and/or budget for the type of scholarship I am applying for and the final decision of the Lasallian Admission and Scholarship Opportunities Scholarship Committee of the Institute;
3. I shall maintain the minimum grade requirement of 80% without any failing grades in all subjects during the semester; and a minimum General Weighted Average (GWA) of 83%.
4. I shall submit an Accomplishment and Performance Evaluation Report to the Officer of the Lasallian Access & Success Office through the Institutional Student Council & Office of the Student Services' Accredited Student Organization endorsed by the Adviser of ISC and TSAAIO and approved by the Dean of Office of Student Services;
5. I shall apply for renewal of my scholarship every year following the deadline for applications set by the Lasallian Admission and Scholarship Opportunities should I be re-elected in any of the major positions in ISC and TSAAIO;
6. I shall not falsify documents required for my scholarship applications;
7. I shall not be charged or disciplined for any violation (both minor (three (3) consecutive commissions) and major offenses) of school policies and regulations stipulated in the Student Handbook;
8. I shall maintain a full academic load during each semester;
9. I shall be an active member of DLSMHSI Varsity Team and Chorale Group, active officer of the DLSMHSI Institutional Student Council and Office of the Student Services' Accredited Student Organization;
10. I shall attend and support all the resource mobilization projects of the Institute particularly the fund-raising activities;
11. I shall make myself available/present at all times during general assemblies, meetings and other relatable activities of the Lasallian Admission and Scholarship Opportunities;
