Revised Scholarship Policies and Guidelines
S.Y. 2021 – 2022

The College of Medical Laboratory Science (CMLS) follows the Institutional Scholarship Policies and Guidelines set by the Lasallian Admission and Scholarship Opportunities. The Collegiate Scholarship Committee has decided to revise the qualifications of scholarship applicants due to limited funds for this school year 2021 – 2022.

I. Entrance Scholarship

II. Gawad Lasalyanong Edukasyon Scholarship

Gawad Lasalyanong Edukasyon is given to the incoming CMLS students who graduated from biggest science schools with High / Highest Honors and who are also in need of financial assistance.

Pre-requisites:

1. Regular student
2. Filipino citizen and resident of the Philippines
3. Graduate of Science schools and/or biggest public schools (whose Principals are ranked as Principal (3 or 4) in terms of the school population in CALABARZON, Metro Manila and other areas in the country
4. With Highest Honor and with General Weighted Average (GWA) of 97 or higher or its equivalent rating in the other public schools during their Grade 12.
5. With a DLSMHSI College Admissions Test (CAT) score of 170 and above
6. Completed all needed requirements in scholarship application

Tuition Fee Discount
Full tuition including miscellaneous, special assessment, and other fees including book and uniform allowances, physical and other medical examinations required by the College institution and/or DLSMHSI.

III. Academic Scholarship

Academic Scholarship is given to the **TOP 10 CMLS scholarship applicants** with a grade not lower than 85 in their subjects and with General Weight Average (GWA) of at least **93% or above** during their stay in the program.





Pre-requisites:

1. Regular CMLS student
2. Top 10 CMLS scholarship applicant
3. Filipino citizen and resident of the Philippines
4. With a grade not lower than 85 in all subjects
5. General Weighted Average (GWA) qualification of 93% or higher
6. Completed all needed requirements in scholarship application

Note: If the qualified students will not apply for the academic scholarship, the Collegiate Scholarship Committee will automatically rank and assess the academic scholarship applicants according to their general weight average (GWA).

IV. Financial Scholarship

Financial Scholarship is given to the CMLS scholarship applicants with a grade not lower than 85 in their subjects and with General Weight Average (GWA) of at least **87% or above** during their stay in the program.

Pre-requisites:

1. Regular CMLS student
2. Filipino citizen and resident of the Philippines
3. With a grade not lower than 85 in all subjects
4. General Weighted Average (GWA) qualification of 87% or higher
5. Completed all needed requirements in scholarship application
6. Passed the background check and interview of the scholarship committee

Extremely needed	30%
Highly Needed	20%
Moderately Needed	10%

Note: Tuition fee discount for financial scholarship is subject for changes & approval depending on the availability of scholarship budget.

V. Service Scholarship

Service Scholarship is given to the CMLS scholarship applicants with a grade not lower than 85 in their subjects and with General Weight Average (GWA) of at least **87% or above** during their stay in the program.





Pre-requisites:

1. Regular CMLS student
2. Officers of the Institutional Student Council – Executive Board (ISC-EB) and Legislative Assembly Officers; College Student Council Presidents (CSC-President); Executive Officers of accredited institutional student organizations and their college representatives
3. Filipino citizen and resident of the Philippines
4. With a grade not lower than 85 in all subjects
5. General Weighted Average (GWA) qualification of 87% or higher
6. Completed all needed requirements in scholarship application

Institutional Student Council-Legislative Assembly officers; Accredited institutional student organizations and their college representatives	10%

VI. Externally Funded Scholarships

Requirements and policies for this type of scholarship are set by the sponsoring organizations and are evaluated by the offices concerned but the applicants are required to file their applications at the Lasallian Admission and Scholarship Opportunities.

VII. Employees' Dependents (EDSP) / Grand Father Clause (GFCSP) Scholarship Program

Are scholarship benefits given to the children of DLSMHSI regular employees who wish to enroll in DLSMHSI and DLSU-D.

Pre-requisites:

1. Regular employee of De La Salle Medical and Health Sciences Institute
2. Completed all needed requirements in scholarship application
