**COLLEGIATE CRITERIA ON SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS
AND APPROVAL FOR AY 2021-2022**

A) Academic Scholarship

- Accommodation and approval shall depend on the availability of slots and/ or budget for the college.
- The scholar applicant must belong to the Top 5 of the batch.
- The scholar applicant must have satisfied all the application requirements stipulated in the student handbook.
- The scholar applicant must have satisfied the grade requirement based on the following criteria:

YEAR LEVEL	GWA	DISCOUNT
1 st to 4 th year	98-100	75%
	95-97	50%
	92-94	25%

B) Financial Scholarship

- Strict compliance to the requirements stated in the student handbook shall be implemented.
- An option for virtual/ online interview to the applicant and parents/ guardian may be scheduled upon review of the application documents.
- Approval shall be based on the result of interview, the documents submitted, and the availability of funds, and from the following criteria:

YEAR LEVEL	GWA and EXTENT of FINANCIAL NEED	DISCOUNT
1 st year (2 nd Sem) to 4 th year	98-100 and extremely needed	75%
	95-97 and highly needed	50%
	90-94 and moderately needed	25%

C) Service Scholarship

- Approval shall be based on the guidelines stipulated in the student handbook, however, it shall only be limited to the ISC Officers and CNSC president for this academic year..





D) Entrance Scholarship

- The approval will be based on the criteria set by the Lasallian Admission and Scholarship Opportunities (LASO), as approved by the Vice Chancellor for Academics.

E) Bro. President Scholarship

- Approval shall depend on the grade requirement stipulated in the student handbook, on the recommendation coming from the office of the Bro. President, on the application documents submitted, and on the availability of funds.

F) Externally Funded Scholarship (UTFI)

- As is from the CN scholarship guidelines (Changes may depend on the sponsor's capacity to sustain the grant).
