



Subject: CRS Revised Scholarship Application Criteria Guidelines SY 2021 - 2022

Dear Sir,

Greetings in St. La Salle!

The Student Activities, Scholarships, Promotion and Admission Committee (SASPAC) of the College of Rehabilitation Sciences has agreed on the following revisions to the collegiate scholarship guidelines for AY 2021-2022. We propose the following for approval.

First Priority: Graduating Students

1. Give scholarship grants for the old and new academic and financial scholarships.

Second Priority: Academic Scholarship

1. Give academic scholarship grants only to those in the Top 5 to Top 10 per batch of each program given the allowable budget.
2. Prioritize the old academic scholarship applicants followed by new applicants.

Third Priority: Financial Scholarship

1. Give financial scholarship grants only to those applicants in the Top 5 to Top 10 given the allowed budget
2. Give priority to the old financial applicants followed by new applicants.
3. Require applicants to present and submit a Certificate of Indigency as proof of their financial incapability.
4. Screen possible applicants via an online interview thoroughly.
5. No need to visit the house or do background check during the online interview.
6. Follow other requirements stipulated in the student handbook except the ITR form

Service Scholarship

1. No service scholar applicants will be accepted in the college except if the student is the president of the institutional student council as requested by The Student Affairs.
